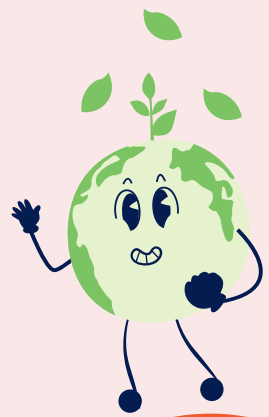
WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY JUNE 5TH 2025
