# Founders Day Celebration

At St. Chavara institutions and churches, Founder's Day is observed in honour of Saint Kuriakose Elias Chavara, the founder of the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI)—the first indigenous religious congregation in India—and a major figure in education and social reform. January 3 every year is observed as Founder's Day because this is the feast day of St. Kuriakose Elias Chavara, marking the anniversary of his death in 1871.



# Pongal Day Celebration



The Pongal concept is a four-day Tamil harvest festival celebrating gratitude to the Sun God (Surya), Mother Nature, and farm animals for a bountiful harvest, symbolizing prosperity with the word "Pongal" meaning "to boil over" (overflow) and referring to the sweet rice dish cooked to overflowing. It marks the start of the Tamil month of Thai, the end of winter, and the Sun's northward journey (Uttarayan). Key themes include new beginnings, thanksgiving, family togetherness, and cultural renewal through rituals like Kolam (rangoli) and honoring cattle.



# Pongal Day Celebration






# Book publication

# Teachers orientation




